Summer Hours

May 29-September 6, 2010

Monday-Saturday 10:00 am-9:00 pm
Sunday 11:00 am-9:00 pm

The pool and exercise room are cleared 15 minutes prior to closing.

Beginning August 16th, the "Lake" and surrounding deck areas will close at 8:00 pm due to darkness. The instructional and kiddy pools, as well as the exercise room will remain open until 8:45 pm.

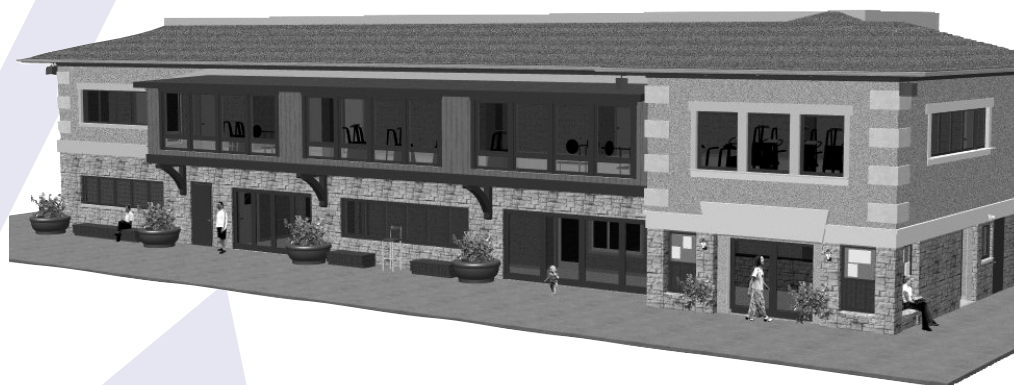
Children 13-15 must be accompanied and supervised by their parent. Children 12 and under will not be admitted during the early morning.

Member Lap Swimming Schedules

Our club is fortunate to have lap swimming available during all regular club hours. Below is a list of the three areas for Lap Swim and the schedule for each area. All 50 meter lanes are closed during swimming meets. Lap lanes will be available in the pool and lake during this time.

- Unless the pool is being used for programs, the 20 yard lap lanes in the instructional pool are available for use during club hours.

Guest Ticket Information

Associate guest tickets may be purchased on the ground floor of the business office on or after opening day. Please review guest ticket policies on page 3 in the Club Rule Book.

Cost

- Single tickets are \$7.00 each.

Quantities

- Single Memberships are allowed **20** single guest tickets per membership year.
- Family Memberships are allowed **25** single guest tickets per membership year.

Usage

- Summer weekday use: *One Ticket* per guest per day.
- Summer weekend and holiday use: *Two Tickets* per guest per day.
- Guests one year of age or older must have a guest ticket(s).
- Club members must accompany their guest(s) and are responsible for the safety and conduct of their guests in the club.
- There is a daily limit of 8 guests.

Swim Shop

Goggles, caps, sunscreen, swim diapers, inflatables, and more are for sale in the shop. The shop is located on the ground floor of the business office.

Membership Photos and Cards

New members and returning members, whose physical appearance has changed significantly, may have their photos taken at the front gate on or after opening day of the summer season. As always, cards from past years are still valid. If your card is damaged it may be replaced at no charge at anytime, providing you present the old card to the attendant at the front gate. If you have lost your card, **replacement cards may be purchased at the front gate for \$5.00.**

Please have your membership card ready when arriving at the front gate for member check-in. If you are checking in more than one member on the same membership, ask to "show family." This will expedite the check-in process. Members failing to bring their card to the club will experience a delay in the check-in process.

Lockers and Pages

Lockers rented for the 2009-10 season must have padlocks removed by May 20, 2010 or the locks will be cut off and items in the locker will be donated to charity.

Lockers rented for 2010-11 and page numbers will be available in the First Aid Office on or after opening day. Lockers must be claimed by July 15th or your locker will be issued to a member on the waiting list.

Please review locker regulations in the Club Rule Book.

Picnic Table Reservations

The 10 picnic tables located by the bull pen and 25 yard lanes, and the deck area of the Eckard building are available to reserve. Reservations are limited to 5 hour time blocks and 3 reservations per summer per family. All other tables are for occasional use only. Please review the picnic table policies on page 11 in the Club Rule Book.

New Family Restroom

A new single use restroom is now located on the first floor of the Thompson Building. This unisex restroom is for adult members and their opposite gender children under 5. As stated in the Club Rule Book, no one under the age of 5 is to be in an opposite gender changing room. Please help by reporting any infractions.
